# AKC<sup>®</sup> Code of Sportsmanship and Civility

Preface: The tradition of competitive purebred dog events predates 1884 – the year the American Kennel Club (AKC) was founded. Those involved in these sports share core values, including a strong commitment to sportsmanship and a welcoming, respectful culture that embraces the diverse community united by a love of dogs.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: Conformation, Performance, Companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years.

Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.

- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can – and should – coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.

#### **IMPORTANT**

**TRANSFERS** of **dogs** from regular classes to Best of Breed/Variety competition (CH 11, Section 6, AKC Rules applying to dog shows) MUST be made to the Superintendent/Event Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at this show.

**TRANSFERS** by **Junior** Handlers from Novice to Open class or from Open to Master class MUST be made to the Superintendent/Event Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

**SUBSTITUTIONS** of **Junior** Showmanship dogs must be made prior to the judging of the class at the show.

**TRANSFERS OF DOGS IN OBEDIENCE/RALLY CLASSES** (Ch 1, Section 16 of Obedience regulations) The request for transfers must be in writing and presented to the Superintendent/Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each Trial. Transfers for Obedience may ne approved, provided the next level class and judge are available and the class has not reached it's limit.

Judges may request the ramp to judge any breed in emergency situations. If granted, unless the use of a ramp has been indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. Junior showmanship judges should follow the above. #### **NOTICE JUNIORS**

Junior handlers who win a third Novice class with competition present or a first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show, ARE REQUIRED TO TRANSFER their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class. They must notifiy the Superintendent/Event Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

#### PEE WEE SPECIAL ATTRACTIONS

The Pee Wee Class is geared toward children 5-9 years of age. Safety is our primary concern.

Mentor: Mr. Paul Bodeving

**PEE WEE CLASS:** Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, guardian/parent/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one unit in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and adult.

- Dog must be at least 12 months of age.
- Bitches in season will not participate.
- All dogs must have the proper lead and collar.
- The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.

Prizes will include Rosette Ribbon and Dog Toy for all participants.

Event will be before Junior Showmanship. Each entrant must complete a <u>release waiver</u> er signed by parent or legal guardian before the classes begin.



The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler (if offered) class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in

the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

Professional handlers\*, household members and current assistants\*\* to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. For a detailed description of the National Owner-Handled Series, please visit the AKC website NOHS pages at:

- \*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
- \*\*A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

The Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed competition. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the undefeated winners of the non-Regular (single dog entry) Classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during Regular Classes and winners competition.

#### JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present or a first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show, ARE REQUIRED to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class. Junior MUST NOTIFY the Superintendent/Event Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

**(A) NOVICE CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class with competition present at a licensed or member show.

**(B) OPEN CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class with competition present at a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open Class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 60 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

**(C) MASTER CLASS:** This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

#### (D) JUNIOR, INTERMEDIATE AND SENIOR CLASSES.

The Novice and Open regular classes may be divided by age into Junior, Intermediate and Senior Classes, provided the division is specified in the premium list. A Junior Class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show.

The Intermediate Class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show. The Senior Class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

JUNIORS WITH A DOG ALSO ENTERED IN ANOTHER CLASS OFFERED AT THIS SHOW WHO SUBSTITUTE A DOG NOT ENTERED IN THIS SHOW MUST REMIT THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN JUNIOR ONLY AND JUNIOR AS AN ADDITIONAL CLASS ENTRY FEE. JUNIORS WHO HAVE ENTERED JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP ONLY WHO THEN SUBSTITUTE ANOTHER DOG WILL NOT BE CHARGED A FURTHER FEF.

#### **AKC SANCTIONED 4-6 MONTH PUPPY COMPETITION**

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for Saint Bernards that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

#### **Entry and Eligibility**

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if it is registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veter-inarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Entries must be marked "Exhibition Only" prior to the close of entries.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

Entries Close at the home of the Show Secretary Wednesday, September 3, 2025, 12:00 pm CDT.

One combined class will be offered for St. Bernards that are four (4) months of age and over but under six (6) months on the day of the event.

CLASSIFICATION- CLASSES COMBINED – PUPPY, 4 & UNDER 6 MONTHS IF ENTRY EXCEEDS 25, A SECOND JUDGE MAY BE ASSIGNED.

NO PUPPIES UNDER THE AGE OF SIX (6) MONTHS, EXCEPT THOSE PARTICIPATING IN THE 4-6 MONTH PUPPY COMPETITION, MAY BE ON THE GROUNDS.

Division 13 is comprised of: Idaho, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, New Mexico, North Dakota, South Dakota, Utah, Wyoming.

For complete Conformation Championship requirements see Chapter 16 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows

The Points toward a Championship shall be awarded to the Winners Dog and Bitch of each breed or variety based on the actual number of dogs or bitches competing in that breed or variety.

If the dog designated Winners Dog of Winners Bitch is also awarded Best of Breed or Variety, the dogs of both sexes that have been entered for Best of Breed of Variety competition and that have been defeated in such competition, shall be counted in addition to the dogs that completed in the regular classes for its sex in calculating championship points.

If the dog designated Winners Dog or Winners Bitch is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed or Variety, the dogs of its own sex that have been entered for Best of Breed or Variety competition that have been defeated in competition for Best of Opposite Sex, shall be counted in addition to the dogs that completed in the regular classes for its sex in calculating championship points.

After points have been computed for Winners Dog and Winners Bitch subject to the above two stipulations, the dog awarded the Best of Winners shall be credited with the number of points calculated for Winners Dog or Winners Bitch, whichever is greater.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, or from which all awards are withheld shall not be included. Any dog which shall have won fifteen points shall become a Champion of Record, if six or more of said points shall have been won at two shows with a rating of three or more championship points each and under two different judges, and some one or more of the balance of said points shall have been won under some other judge or judges than the two judges referred to above.

#### Dogs In Rooms Rules Per SBCA Policy

Effective with the 2024 National Specialty, the SBCA established the following rules that attendees must follow in order to keep dogs in guest rooms of the host hotel. "Guest room" definition includes, but is not limited to rooms, condos, suites, cabins or units, no matter how many bedrooms are involved.

- A total of no more than 2 dogs (no matter what breed) per room/condo/suite/cabin/unit.
- Any exception has to be approved by the SBCA Board.
- Dogs must be crated at all times while in a guest room. Appropriate measures must be taken to protect the carpet and surrounding areas under and near the crate. Recommendation to have a handout given to each exhibitor stating the crating policy at check-in.
- It is at the Show Chairperson discretion to have exhibitor's rooms checked that the SBCA dog policy is being enforced.
- The guest agrees to take full financial liability for all damages by the pet including but not limited to, odor, damaging furniture or any part of the room, urination, etc. This includes other parts of the hotel where the dog may have to pass through to get to the rooms, i.e. the hallways and elevators.
- A pet fee charge per day, per room, may be applied to the hotel bill.
- Hotels may charge an additional security deposit.

#### Poop Fine Per SBCA Policy

Decency is about treating other people and their property with respect, thoughtfulness and consideration. It's about behaving in a way that shows that you care about others. It also creates a positive environment that encourages others to act in a similar manner. The SBCA endeavors to be a beacon of respect to others and the venues where we host our National Specialty and therefore will enforce the following "SBCA Poop Fine Policy".

Any person who does not pick up after their dog on any part of the show grounds and hotel site for the National including but not limited to the ring area, parking lots, grassy areas and event sites, shall be subject to a \$50.00 fine. This notice will be printed in the Premium List as well as posted on the show's website. Further notices will be posted throughout the show site, including placing flyers in any hospitality bags or with registration handouts. The Show Committee, if necessary, will obtain a list of offenders and submit the list to the Board and the SBCA President will authorize a written letter of reprimand to the offenders.

# FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES WILL RESULT IN A BENCH SHOW HEARING AND FINES

#### NATIONAL SPECIALTY BREEDER ACHIEVEMENT AWARD (NSBAA)

The National Specialty Breeder Achievement Award is presented each year to the breeders/co-breeders who has/have had the most success exhibiting at that National. The point calculations comprising this award are the responsibility of the Board members in the Region in which the show is held. Proxy(s) may be designated if Regional Board members are unavailable to tally points. For mor information see the National Catalog when available.

#### NO PRACTICING ALLOWED IN RINGS AT ANY TIME

Dogs may arrive at any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS - Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the Event Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**ALL DOGS PRESENT** must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

**PRIZES** will be awarded in the ring to the person showing the dog where practicible.

**Please note:** Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this week may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 11, Sec. 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs (with the exception of service dogs).

**LOSS OR DAMAGE** – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows.

The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, proof of rabies vaccination may be rquired at the site. Exhibitors should have proof of Rabies vaccination available for all dogs under their control.

#### **ATTENTION EXHIBITORS**

- Admission is free- no space allotted for unentered dogs (Except service animals)
- Turn off all cell phones and pagers before entering the ring.
- No Smoking in any Building or Tent
- Parents are responsible for their children and their actions on the grounds and adjacent areas
- Dogs over six months old require Rabies vaccination- proof may be required.
- All classes will assemble in armband order unless otherwise directed by the Steward.
- Any cash prizes will be paid to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be
  made in the ring before the judging of the breed is over, and the Event Secretary advised at
  once. The Event Secretary and show giving clubs disclaim any liability after the judging of
  the breed is over.
- Prize money must be collected in the ring at the time of the win. None will be distributed later.
- All Trophies must be claimed on the day of the show, none will be mailed.

Dog/Dogs found in an unsafe environment, in distress, or in harm's way will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog/dogs to an unsafe environment is considered mistreatment. Examples of an unsafe environment are, but not limited to: Dog/Dogs left unattended on a grooming table in a noose that is not attached to a safety release clip; Dog/Dogs left in a vehicle without proper ventilation.

The Clubs and The Event Secretary caution all persons entering the show site and show grounds against a; hazards which may exist, including, but not limited to: Condition of the site/grounds, parking loading & unloading areas, entrances, floors and stairways, elevators, escalators, floor coverings, walkways, tenting & canopies, electrical appliances, cords and fittings, exercise pens and the presence of animals. All persons should take into consideration this is a sporting event and dress, act and exercise caution appropriate to the activity involved.

All persons entering the show, the grounds, site and show areas for whatever purpose do so entirely at their own risk. By virtue of entering the show, the entrant has indicated their acceptance of the terms listed in the Premium list and assumes all risks involved.

#### ATTENTION EXHIBITORS OF FOREIGN DOGS

Effective August 1, 2024 the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) is expanding requirements for the importation/entry of foreign dogs into the United States. Requirements include that all dogs must be at least 6 months of age, microchipped, complete new CDC Dog Import forms, and have a valid rabies vaccination or be able to demonstrate residence in a DMRVV (canine rabies)-free or low risk country for the last 6 months.
