AKC Code Of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

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****Points Awarded for Reserve****

All Clubs will award a three-point major to Reserve Winners Dog if the Regular Class Dog entry is twice the required number for a five-point major in the division where the Specialty is held.

All Clubs will award a three-point major to Reserve Winners Bitch if the Regular Class Bitch entry is twice the required number for a five-point major in the division where the Specialty is held.

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler (if offered) class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the

judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. For a detailed description of the National Owner-Handled Series, please visit the AKC website NOHS pages at:

*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

**A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

The Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed competition. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the undefeated winners of the non-Regular (single dog entry) Classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during Regular Classes and winners competition.

**Entry into NOHS is NOT automatic!
Remember to check the box near the
bottom of the entry form if eligible.**

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present or a first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show, ARE REQUIRED to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class. Junior MUST NOTIFY the Superintendent/Event Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

AKC Junior Handler Numbers are now required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club - PHONE: (919) 233-9767. For additional information contact American Kennel Club, Junior Showmanship, P.O. Box 900051, Raleigh, NC 27675- 9051. Phone (919) 233-9767 or E-mail: juniors@akc.org. Entry blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

(A) NOVICE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class with competition present at a licensed or member show.

(B) OPEN CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class with competition present at a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open Class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 60 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

(B) MASTER CLASS: This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

(D) Junior, Intermediate and Senior Classes.

The Novice and Open regular classes may be divided by age into Junior, Intermediate and Senior Classes, provided the division is specified in the premium list. A Junior Class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show. The Intermediate Class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show. The Senior Class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

JUNIORS WITH A DOG ALSO ENTERED IN ANOTHER CLASS OFFERED AT THIS SHOW WHO SUBSTITUTE A DOG NOT ENTERED IN THIS SHOW MUST REMIT THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN JUNIOR ONLY AND JUNIOR AS AN ADDITIONAL CLASS ENTRY FEE. JUNIORS WHO HAVE ENTERED JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP ONLY WHO THEN SUBSTITUTE ANOTHER DOG WILL NOT BE CHARGED A FURTHER FEE.

AKC SANCTIONED 4-6 MONTH PUPPY COMPETITION

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for Saint Bernards that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if it is registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Entries must be marked "Exhibition Only" prior to the close of entries.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

Entries Close at the home of the Show Secretary Wednesday, September 3, 2025, 12:00 pm EDT.

One combined class will be offered for St. Bernards that are four (4) months of age and over but under six (6) months on the day of the event.

**CLASSIFICATION - CLASSES COMBINED – PUPPY, 4 & UNDER 6 MONTHS
IF ENTRY EXCEEDS 25, A SECOND JUDGE MAY BE ASSIGNED.**

NO PUPPIES UNDER THE AGE OF SIX (6) MONTHS, EXCEPT THOSE PARTICIPATING IN THE 4-6 MONTH PUPPY COMPETITION, MAY BE ON THE GROUNDS.

SCHEDULE OF POINTS FOR DIVISION 13 - EFFECTIVE MAY 12, 2025

Division 13 is comprised of: Idaho, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, New Mexico, North Dakota, South Dakota, Utah, Wyoming.

For complete Conformation Championship requirements see Chapter 16 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows

The Points toward a Championship shall be awarded to the Winners Dog and Bitch of each breed or variety based on the actual number of dogs or bitches competing in that breed or variety.

If the dog designated Winners Dog or Winners Bitch is also awarded Best of Breed or Variety, the dogs of both sexes that have been entered for Best of Breed or Variety competition and that have been defeated in such competition, shall be counted in addition to the dogs that completed in the regular classes for its sex in calculating championship points.

If the dog designated Winners Dog or Winners Bitch is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed or Variety, the dogs of its own sex that have been entered for Best of Breed or Variety competition that have been defeated in competition for Best of Opposite Sex, shall be counted in addition to the dogs that completed in the regular classes for its sex in calculating championship points.

After points have been computed for Winners Dog and Winners Bitch subject to the above two stipulations, the dog awarded the Best of Winners shall be credited with the number of points calculated for Winners Dog or Winners Bitch, whichever is greater.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, or from which all awards are withheld shall not be included. Any dog which shall have won fifteen points shall become a Champion of Record, if six or more of said points shall have been won at two shows with a rating of three or more championship points each and under two different judges, and some one or more of the balance of said points shall have been won under some other judge or judges than the two judges referred to above.

Reserved Grooming

A limited number of reserved grooming spaces will be available inside the Marriott Event Center in the Sand Hills room, located adjacent to the conformation ring. Each assigned 10' wide x 10' deep spot will include enough room for two crates and a grooming table and includes electricity.

The cost is \$150 for the week for each space. Reserve two spaces and the price is \$280 for the week.

Every effort will be made to open the building for move-in by noon Sunday. When reserving grooming space, we encourage you to plan ahead and "buddy-up" with friends. By sharing with friends and coordinating the use of the reserved space and electrical resources, you will make it possible for more people to reserve space to groom.

This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. Additional entries of the same dog will have an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.50 per dog.

NO ENTRY shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition to its acceptance.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

The show-giving club and the Event Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS OF FOREIGN DOGS

Effective August 1, 2024 the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) is expanding requirements for the importation/entry of foreign dogs into the United States. Requirements include that all dogs must be at least 6 months of age, microchipped, complete new CDC Dog Import forms, and have a valid rabies vaccination or be able to demonstrate residence in a DMRVV (canine rabies)-free or low risk country for the last 6 months. 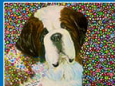

DOGS IN ROOMS PER SBCA POLICY

Effective with the 2024 National Specialty, the SBCA established the following rules that attendees must follow in order to keep dogs in guest rooms of the host hotel. “Guest room” definition includes, but is not limited to rooms, condos, suites, cabins or units, no matter how many bedrooms are involved.

- A total of no more than 2 dogs (no matter what breed) per room/condo/suite/cabin/unit.
- Any exception has to be approved by the SBCA Board.
- Dogs must be crated at all times while in a guest room. Appropriate measures must be taken to protect the carpet and surrounding areas under and near the crate. Recommendation to have a handout given to each exhibitor stating the crating policy at check-in.
- It is at the Show Chairperson discretion to have exhibitor’s rooms checked that the SBCA dog policy is being enforced.
- The guest agrees to take full financial liability for all damages by the pet including but not limited to, odor, damaging furniture or any part of the room, urination, etc. This includes other parts of the hotel where the dog may have to pass through to get to the rooms, i.e. – the hallways and elevators.
- A pet fee charge per day, per room, may be applied to the hotel bill.
- Hotels may charge an additional security deposit.

SBCA POOP FINE PER SBCA POLICY

Decency is about treating other people and their property with respect, thoughtfulness and consideration. It’s about behaving in a way that shows that you care about others. It also creates a positive environment that encourages others to act in a similar manner. The SBCA endeavors to be a beacon of respect to others and the venues where we host our National Specialty and therefore will enforce the following “SBCA Poop Fine Policy”.

Any person who does not pick up after their dog on any part of the show grounds and hotel site for the National including but not limited to the ring area, parking lots, grassy areas and event sites, shall be subject to a \$50.00 fine. This notice will be printed in the Premium List as well as posted on the show’s website. Further notices will be posted throughout the show site, including placing flyers in any hospitality bags or with registration handouts. The Show Committee, if necessary, will obtain a list of offenders and submit the list to the Board and the SBCA President will authorize a written letter of reprimand to the offenders.

The SBCA created a non-regular class (one for Dogs and a one for Bitches) at the National Specialty Show called the "Working Dog Class." The class shall be placed following the competition for Winners Dog/Bitch and immediately before Veteran Dog/Bitch. The criteria for entering the class is as follows: 1) Any dog or bitch entered in these classes must have achieved any of the approved SBCA Working Dog titles, for example, Draft Dog (DD) or Weight Pull (WP). 2) Any Dog or bitch winning entered in these classes must be intact. 3) Any dog or bitch winning first place in these classes will be eligible for competition in the Best of Breed Class.

BITCHES

Working Bitch
Veteran Bitch 7 years and over

Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "Neutered dogs and spayed bitches would be allowed to compete in Veterans Classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed." Spayed Bitches and Neutered Dogs may be entered in Veteran Classes, Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace.

Best Of Breed

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION: The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record, and dogs that according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owner's records. AKC Best Of Winners, Select Dog and Select Bitch will be awarded during Best of Breed competition.

Non-Regular Classes

(Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

Stud Dog
Brood Bitch
Brace

Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

Stud Dog Class and Brood Bitch Class: Each entry is allowed two get. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. All get must be entered in a regular class in order to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

Brace Class: Two Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class."

Bred By Exhibitor Eligibility

- All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC.
- The persons handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.
- To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

Best Bred-By Exhibitor

Best bred-by exhibitor involves the winners of all of the Bred-By Exhibitor classes. Even if one dog or bitch has beaten another by virtue of receiving winners or reserve from the classes, all class winners return to the ring for the judging. This is a separate attraction. What happened in the regular classes has no bearing on this award.

Best Puppy

Best puppy involves the winners of the 6-9 and 9-12 puppy classes. Even if one puppy has beaten another by virtue of receiving winners or reserve from the classes, all four puppy class winners return to the ring for the judging of best puppy. This is a separate attraction. What happened in the regular classes has no bearing on the best Puppy award.

Best Veteran

Best Veteran involves the winners of all of the Veteran classes. Even if one Veteran has beaten another by virtue of receiving winners or reserve from the classes, all four class winners return to the ring for the judging of best Veteran. This is a separate attraction. What happened in the regular classes has no bearing on the best Veteran award.

PRIZES: Trophies, Ribbons, Certificates, or other prizes will be awarded in the ring to the person exhibiting the dog, who shall be considered the owner or agent. Please advise the Superintendent of any discrepancy at once. The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

AWARDS OF MERIT

This award is to recognize excellence beyond Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed.

All Saints eligible for the Best of Breed class, except those awarded Best-Of-Breed, Best Of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch are eligible to be given an “Award-Of-Merit” (AOM) subject to the following restrictions:

- The maximum number of AOM's that may be awarded shall be ten percent (10%) of the total number of entries in the Best of Breed class, INCLUDING Winners Dog and Winners Bitch, Veteran class winners, Working Dog winner, Working Bitch winner, and those dogs moved up to Breed per AKC rules. In calculating the maximum number of AOMs allowable under the 10% rule, any fractional number shall be rounded off to the next highest whole number. For example: with 67 Best of Breed Saints entered, plus WD, WB, Veteran Dog, Veteran Bitch, Working Dog and Working Bitch (total number of 73), ten percent is 7.3, thus rounding off the maximum number of AOMs that may be awarded is 8, the next highest number.
- The judge may withhold any or all of the AOMs for lack of merit.
- There shall be no limitation of the awarding of AOM's with respect to sex.
- Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog and Select Bitch are NOT eligible for AOM, however both Winners Dog and Winners Bitch are eligible for AOM.
- All AOMs receive the same recognition and awards.
- AOM's are chosen immediately following the Best of Breed, Best of Winners, and Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. The dogs must remain in the ring to receive the awards.

PEE WEE & ITTY-BITTY SPECIAL ATTRACTIONS

The Pee Wee Class is geared toward children 5-9 years of age. The Itty-Bitty class is for children 3-5 years of age. Safety is our primary concern.

Judge:

PEE WEE CLASS: Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, guardian/parent/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one unit in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and adult.

- Dog must be at least 12 months of age.
- Bitches in season will not participate.
- All dogs must have the proper lead and collar.

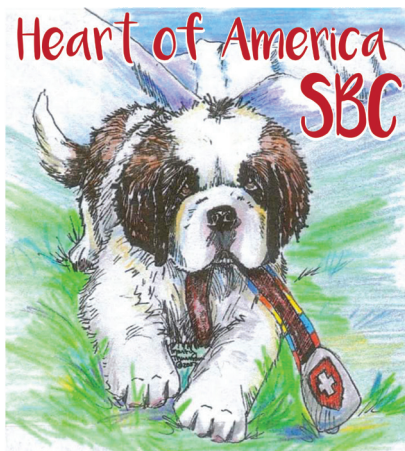

Best Bred-By Exhibitor

Best bred-by exhibitor involves the winners of all of the Bred-By Exhibitor classes. What happened in the regular classes has no bearing on this award.

Best Puppy

Best puppy involves the winners of the 6-9 and 9-12 puppy classes. Even if one puppy has beaten another by virtue of receiving winners or reserve from the classes, all four puppy class winners return to the ring for the judging of best puppy. This is a separate attraction. What happened in the regular classes has no bearing on the Best Puppy award.

Best Veteran

Best Veteran involves the winners of all of the Veteran classes. Even if one Veteran has beaten another by virtue of receiving winners or reserve from the classes, all four class winners return to the ring for the judging of best Veteran. This is a separate attraction. What happened in the regular classes has no bearing on the Best Veteran award.

The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
